Enoc Perez is known for his paintings of nudes, modern architecture, and stylized shapes. Often vibrantly and alternatively colored, and with a loose, sketch-like quality to his brushwork, he pulls influence from both the Abstract expressionists, such as Jackson Pollock, and from Pop artists such as Andy Warhol. He has also been known to experiment with different ways of applying pigment, giving his works the appearance of a silkscreen, though he most often uses oil paint.
